BottleDrop Give Account

We now have a returnable can and bottle drop account for the club. Anyone can pick up green bags from **BottleDrop Give** <https://bottledrop.com/> (across from Bi-Mart in Albany) and turn in cans and bottles at any time, which will be credited to our account (we will email you our special number as soon as we are assigned one). Cans and bottles do not have to be pre-sorted and there is a "Green Bag Bottle Dropoff" where anyone with our account number can drop off up to 50 bags at one time without waiting for the machines. Use that number when you drop off bottles so the club will get credit. (Each bag should be below 20lbs.) **BottleDrop Give** collects 8% for processing, and Fred Schafer will periodically request payment to the club.
