Lebanon Square Circlers

Lebanon Square Circlers have been dancing since 1949 and is the second oldest square dance club in Oregon. The club started after the American Legion Auxiliary sponsored lessons, and has been running continuously ever since. Located in Lebanon, Oregon, heart of the Willamette Valley, the club insignia is the strawberry. Celebrating the Lebanon Strawberry Festival every year, the club joins in the festivities by participating in the Strawberry parade and sponsoring dances and activities during the first full weekend in June. Dances are held every first and third Saturday night (September—June) at the Odd Fellows Hall (IOOF), 20 East Ash Street, with Pre-Rounds starting at 7:30pm, Mainstream at 8:00pm and Plus at 10:00pm. The club welcomes couples, singles and family groups. Lessons begin every September and the club welcomes any interested individuals and especially families. Dances and Lessons are \$6.00 (except for the Birthday and Strawberry Festival ALLIANCE Dances). Family rate is \$14.00 (2 adults and all children under age 18). Clean-Up Duty

- Wipe all dining room tables.
- Put extra food out on the table in the lobby to be picked up.
- Vacuum dining room floor.
- Dust mop dance floor after dance.
- Gather all garbage from restrooms, dining rooms and kitchen into one bag and take home. Replace garbage bags as needed.
- Check to see if lights are turned out in the store room and the restrooms after the dance.
- Check to see that the lights are out in the kitchen and the door is locked.
- Make sure someone brings the Sandwich Board Sign in.
- Make sure the doors to the dining room and the dance hall are closed, the kitchen door is locked, and that **both** doors leading outside are locked when you leave.
- Make sure the garbage goes home with someone.

Door Duty

- Meet Treasurer (or representative) at 7:15pm to accept money box and count out \$50.
- Primary: Accept dance fees and make sure each dancer signs Attendance Sheet.
- Secondary: Accept Split the Pot fees (3 tickets for \$1.00) and separate tickets; give one half to the dancer and put the other half in the Pot.
- Write receipts and attach sticky notes as needed for other money received (dues, etc.).
- Around 8:15pm, total dancers by Club and give tally to President. Count and total money and return money box to Treasurer - go dance!
- Assist with clean up at the end of the dance

Lessons

Lessons begin every September and the club welcomes any interested individuals.

Lessons usually run 3-1/2 to 4 months.

You do not have to have a partner to square dance! Solo dancers and families welcome!

Square Dance Etiquette

Square dance clubs need club member support in order to operate - you do this by:

- Attending all club dances possible.
- Bringing finger-foods to every club dance.
- Attending club visitations.
- Attending club meetings and social activities.
- Helping out with decorations for special dances and helping with other special projects.
- Signing up for Dance Duty at least once a year (remember-YOU are responsible for finding a replacement if you can't make it).
- Paying dues in a timely manner.
- Helping "Angel" new dancers at lessons.
- Taking a turn as an officer.
- Attending special "ALLIANCE" events.

The "ALLIANCE"

The ALLIANCE consists of four clubs that support each other: Corvallis Squares, Albany Timber Twirlers, Lebanon Square Circlers and Sweet Home Squarenaders. The ALLIANCE sponsors a Plus Dance every second Friday, held at the Albany IOOF Hall, as well as designates certain Mainstream Dances at the various clubs as special "ALLIANCE Dances," including Birthday Dances. All members of the ALLIANCE clubs are strongly encouraged to support the ALLIANCE Special Dances.

Kitchen Duty

SETUP:

- Check large garbage can for trash. Put in a fresh bag for our use as needed. Garbage bags are under the small sink by the door.
- Cupboards and drawers above and below the coffee maker are square dance storage. Other supplies are in the storeroom.
- As food arrives, put anything that needs to be cold in the refrigerator.
- Keep the kitchen door shut to discourage grazing.
- Make ice water in the pitcher (in the far lower cupboards under the knife stand). Refill ice cube trays. Place water jug in the dining room on the small white cart with a drip catcher attached. Place cups on the cart with the jug.
- Set out marker pens with the water for people to label their cups.
- Make sure there is at least a 5 to 6 inch stack of thin paper plates with napkins between them on the serving table and set out hand sanitizer.
- Put out utensils.
- Put food on the serving table about 15 minutes before break.

CLOSING:

- Check refrigerator to be sure nothing has been left in it.
- Wash club members' dishes and take to front of hall with any leftover food.
- All IOOF items used should be put back where you found them — *Clean*.
- Dry out the water pitcher and put it away with a loose lid.
- Assist with clean up at the end of the dance.
