Lebanon Square Circlers

Lebanon Square Circlers have been dancing since 1949 and is the second oldest square dance club in Oregon. The club started after the American Legion Auxiliary sponsored lessons, and has been running continuously ever since. Located in Lebanon, Oregon, heart of the Willamette Valley, the club insignia is the strawberry. Celebrating the Lebanon Strawberry Festival every year, the club joins in the festivities by participating in the Strawberry parade and sponsoring dances and activities during the first full weekend in June. Dances are held every first and third Saturday night (September—June) at the Lebanon Senior Center, 80 Tangent Street, with Pre-Rounds at 7:30pm, Mainstream at 8:00pm and Plus every third tip. The club welcomes couples, singles and family groups. Lessons begin every September and the club welcomes any interested individuals and especially families. Dances are \$6.00 and lessons are \$6.00 (except for the Birthday and Strawberry Festival ALLIANCE Dances). Family Rate is \$15.00 (2 adults and all children under 17). Youth Rate is \$3.00. Club Member's Responsibilities

Square dance clubs need club member support in order to operate - you do this by:

- Attending all club dances possible.
- Bringing finger-foods to every club dance.
- Attending club visitations.
- Attending club meetings and social activities.
- Helping out with decorations for special dances and other special projects.
- Signing up for Dance Duty at least once a year (remember-YOU are responsible for finding a replacement if you can't make it).
- Paying dues in a timely manner.
- Helping "Angel" new dancers at lessons.
- Taking a turn as an officer.
- Attending special "ALLIANCE" events.

The "ALLIANCE"

The ALLIANCE consists of four clubs that support each other: Corvallis Squares, Albany Timber Twirlers, Lebanon Square Circlers and Sweet Home Squarenaders. The ALLIANCE sponsors a Plus Dance every third Friday, held at the Albany IOOF Hall, as well as designates certain Mainstream Dances at the various clubs as special "ALLIANCE Dances," including Birthday Dances. All members of the ALLIANCE clubs are *strongly* encouraged to support the ALLIANCE Special Dances.

Set-up

- Members are encouraged to arrive early and/or stay late to help with set-up and take-down of tables and chairs as well as decorations for themed dances, etc. Supplies are in the red tote in the square dance cabinet. Also, by arriving early you are available to greet dancers as they arrive.
- Stay till the end of the dance so you can thank dancers for coming.
- Take the Sandwich Board out.
- Full set-up and take-down instructions can be found on the information table in the service area in a plastic display-stand.

Door Duty

- Come early to set up Cashier's Table (white table on stage) and put strawberry tablecloth on. Supplies are in the red tote in the square dance cabinet.
- Meet Treasurer (or representative) at 7:00pm to accept money box and count out \$75.00.
- Primary Door Person: Accept dance fees and make sure each dancer signs Attendance Sheet (one per line).
- Secondary Door Person: Accept Split the Pot fees (3 tickets for \$1.00) and separate tickets; give one half to the dancer and put the other half in the Split the Pot.
- Write receipts and attach sticky notes as needed for other money received (dues, etc.).
- Around 8:15pm, total dancers by Club and give tally to President. Count and total money and return money box to Treasurer (or President if not available). Pack up Door Duty tote box and leave on the table. Go dance!

Kitchen Duty

- Arrive 30 minutes prior to dance to supervise table set up and to be ready to receive snacks from members as they start to arrive.
- Set up snack/refreshment service area prior to dance and cleaning up the area at end of the dance.
- Supplies are in the black totes in the square dance cabinet. Detailed "Kitchen Duty Guidelines" are hanging on the inside of the storage cabinet door.
- If you have questions or are unable to fulfill your service on your scheduled date, contact Kitchen Chair – Grace Christensen 503-508-4442.

Clean-Up

- Wipe all dining area tables.
- Put tables and chairs away **after** the caller leads the final Thank You (after the last Mainstream Tip).
- Return white Cashier's Table to storage spot at back of stage.
- Make sure someone brings the Sandwich Board Sign in.
- All items used should be put back where you found them — *Clean and dry.*

All tables need to be folded and rolled, not picked UP to move, nor slid on floor, to prevent damage to tables or floor.
