These are Camp Koinonia's Rules:

1. NO Pets of any kind on the camp property (including vehicles). This includes emotional support animals.
2. NO alcohol, drugs, firearms, or fireworks.
3. NO Smoking on site.
4. Campfires are allowed only in the designated pit.
5. Notify the Berkey's immediately if damage occurs to camp property.
6. Children must be supervised at all times, including in the Game Room. (There is a large game room with ping pong and pool tables.) Adults are responsible for making sure children use the camp facilities appropriately. Also, the camp is located in a forested area next to a river. Wild animals and harmful plants are a natural occurrence, so close supervision is necessary for children's protection.
7. Please leave the camp in the same condition it was in when you arrived.

WHAT do I bring? Come with your contagious smiles and happy attitude, along with lawn chairs, outdoor games, table games, dance and walking shoes. Bring your bedding, and everything you need. Bring your musical instruments. What's a campout without live music!

You may leave your square dance attire at home – come dressed for relaxed camping, indoor and outdoor games, dancing and socializing - comfy casual is the dress code for the weekend. Bring your potluck foods and snacks to share. The camp has a fully furnished commercial kitchen available for our use with real dishes, appliances, etc.
